Rules and Regulations:

- 1. Department coordinator should collect the willingness from the departments to register in EDC and the list should be submitted to EDC coordinator.
- 2. Department coordinators should conduct the entrepreneurial skill development programme for the final year students and create awareness among their students from Ist year onwards who ever registered in EDC that report should be submit EDC.
- 3. Two programmes should be conducted for the department concerned (Odd Semester -1).
- 4. Students can write the proposal or innovade the product with the help of production unit and the same can be applied for the funding agency through EDC.

Production Unit:

The main objectives and other salient features of the scheme are,

- Empower the potential of students as a valuable human resource.
- Involve the students in production unit for development of their Practical Knowledge.
- Hands on experience to prepare them better for taking up jobs in future.
- Instill in them with dignity of Labour through learning the Working techniques.
- Prevent students from distractions and engage them in meaningful, positive activities.
- Reduce dependence of regular ministerial staff whose productivity over a period of time should decline considerably.
- Achieve better work efficiency at a lesser cost.

Rules and Regulations:

- 1. Under "Earn While Learn" scheme a student can work for Minimum 3 hours & Maximum 8 hrs per week.
- 2. Sharing between Unit & Management will be 60% (staff 30%, student 30%) & 40%.
- 3. Each unit have to maintain separate A/c note and on 5th of each month sales and profit report with proper sharing split up should be submitted through production unit convenor , Co-Convenor & Director, Centre for Skill Development to Principal.
- 4. Management share should be remitted to NASC Counter(D-Block) and get the acknowledgement of remittance of the amount from the Counter through production unit Co-convenor, convenor & Director, Centre for Skill Development to Principal.
- 5. If monthly target not achieved / any decay products in the Production Unit that should be bared by unit In-charge & HoD. The loss must be informed in writing on the day of the event
- 6. They must submit the proposal for Inventory / Seed money for the Production Unit and get approval through Production Unit Co-convener, Convener& Principal to start a new unit.

- 7. Other than the authorized Production Unit Department / student alone cannot run the units.
- 8. Production should be carried out in the College premises only.
- 9. Cash in hand for short / long period will not be entertained.
- 10. Proposal Should be given for Utilization of the profit money to buy assets for Production Unit.
- 11. HoDs are advised to reduce the clerical works of the production unit In-charge & Convener.
- 12. Products are prepared at home are not permitted to sell in the campus, through Production Unit they can sell in campus.
- 13. If you are interested in producing new products, merging the products, Interdepartmental products kindly get authorization from Principal through Co-convener and Convener.
- 14. For label, Flex printing etc. get authorization from Principal through convener
- 15. HoDs must monitor and report the happening of the Units once in a month and shall stand responsible for each good and bad of the Production Units.

Add- On:

The Skill Based Courses aim to provide additional learner centric graded skill oriented technical training, with the primary objective of improving the employability skills of students. The main objectives of the program are:

- To provide students an understanding of the expectations of industry.
- To improve employability skills of students
- To bridge the skill gaps and make students industry ready.
- To provide an opportunity to students to develop inter-disciplinary skills.

Rules & Regulations

- 1. Add-on courses must be conducted only during the 2nd and 5th Semesters.
- 2. First and final semesters must not be used for Add-on.
- 3. Add-on should be conducted during the initial 10 days of the semester beginning.
- 4. Mid Semester and End Semester timing must not be disturbed because of the tight academic activities.
- 5. UG/PG students must undergo 2/1 Add-on course respectively during the time period mentioned above.
- Add-on Course offered by any company should be understandable and accepted by the students of the concerned department. The MoU (Original copy) must be submitted to the IQAC and a copy must be retained in the dept. file.
- 7. The company/Industry should give orientation about the programme and a report of the same should be submitted to Add-on Committee. The HoDs should ensure this.

- 8. Acceptance letter from each student about the fee and the suitability of the programme should be taken by the HoD. (The format will be given by the Add-on committee).
- 9. Separate attendance register for add on programme must be maintained which should be duly signed by Company Person and HoD.
- 10. Add on classes must be supervised by the Add-on committee members and concerned HoD.
- 11. All HoDs must ensure that the programme title is relevant to the UG/PG students. Minimum 80% hands on training and 20% theory is essential.
- 12. Meetings with Add-on Companies can be arranged by all the HoDs. It will be coordinated by the Add-on Committee.
- 13. Feedback from students about the programme and trainers. From company about the students' performance feedback should be submitted to the committee.
- 14. Placements should be offered by the companies as per MoU. (10% of employment of total strength of final year students).
- 15. Ensure that the course fee is paid by the students on time.
- 16. MoU should be prepared very carefully, including all terms and conditions and Fee for every student, Management share should be clearly mentioned. A draft should be approved by the Principal.
- 17. After completion of the Programme, the tests should be conducted by the Company. The marks are for 100, grading system (A- Excellent (80-100%), B-V. Good (60-80%), C-Average (below 60%) is to be followed, based on their performance and attendance.
- 18. After completion of the course, the certificate format can be submitted to the HoD and the committee for the approval.
