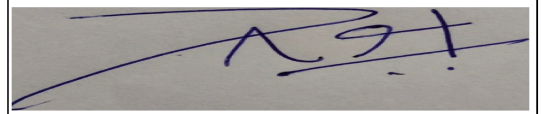

CAT scores of such candidates who are disqualified will become null and void. Such disqualified candidates will not be allowed to appear for CAT in future. If such instances go undetected during the current selection process but are detected in subsequent years, such disqualification and the associated penalties will take place with retrospective effect.
- All queries regarding post-CAT 2022 selection process must be directed to the respective IIMs. CAT Centre will not answer post-CAT queries.
- CAT 2022 score is valid only until 31st December 2023 and is subject to the candidate meeting the minimum eligibility marks in the qualifying examination. The score card will be available on www.iimcat.ac.in till 31st December 2023 to download.
